REQUIREMENT (ELIGIBILITY)

- Full-time male and female undergraduate/graduate students in Ewha School of Business's partner university or equivalent
- Students who have completed at least 1 semester at home university with GPA of 2.5/4.0 (75/100) or above
- Graduate students must provide official transcript of graduate-level studies
- An official transcript must be ready at the stage of application
- English proficiency equivalent to TOEFL iBT 91 or TOEIC 860 recommended

NOMINATION

Nominations are made through Ewha Womans University's online system. It is a required process for exchange students. Visiting or fee-paying students do not need nomination from their home university. Detailed guidelines are sent to partner schools during the nomination period.

- Undergraduate Level: General courses are available. Restrictions may apply to Art & Design, Music, ELTEC Engineering, Education, Scranton Honors Program, and HOKMA College of General Education. Nursing, Medicine, and Pharmacy are not available.
- Graduate Level: The Graduate School courses are available. Some courses in the Graduate School of International Studies are available. English-taught courses of School of Law are available. Courses in the Graduate School of Business courses are available for graduate students only. The Professional Schools and the Special Graduate Schools are not available, except those mentioned above.

AIRPORT PICK-UP

Ewha does **not** provide airport pickup service.

VISA

Students must obtain D-2 student visa before their arrival. Students with F-4 visa does not need D-2 visa. Students need to submit documents to a local Korean Embassy or consulate to apply for the visa. Certificate of Admission and Business Registration Certificate of Ewha will be sent by Ewha to the home university.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You are required to sign up for two different types of insurance during your stay in Korea: the Korean National Health Insurance AND an Insurance of your choice.

[1] Korean National Health Insurance (Mandatory)

All D-2 international students who plan to study in Korea will automatically be subscribed to the Korean National Health Insurance. This is mandatory regardless of whether you already have a similar insurance plan from your home country.

[2] Group Insurance (Ewha Collective Insurance) OR other Insurance (Must choose 1)

In addition to Korean National Health Insurance, students must carry an additional insurance policy. Students may obtain their insurance at their home country or through Ewha Womans University.

※ Cost of Ewha Collective Insurance: 42,000 KRW per semester and 60,000 KRW per year (Fees are subject to change.)

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING (DORMITORY)

Exchange/visiting students can apply for the on-campus housing when they fill out the application form (online). On-campus housing is not guaranteed, and rooms are assigned on a first-come first- serve basis. Negative Tuberculosis test result is required for students who have applied for on-campus housing (blood test, skin test, x-rays are all acceptable).

BUDDY PROGRAM

Peace Buddy program is a partnering program for exchange students. Exchange students will be able to be partnered with Ewha Students and get assistance regarding their exchange at Ewha. Buddy program is not mandatory for students.
