**Saint Martin’s University grants one or two tuition waivers to global partner university exchange students according to the MOU between SMU and the global partner university. Tuition-waiver students who wish to take undergraduate classes must provide proof of English proficiency (minimum score of TOEFL 71 iBT, TOEFL 525 ITP, TOEIC 700, IELTS 6.0 or Duolingo 95). Students who do not meet the English requirement (concurrent status) may be eligible to take two undergraduate classes and two ESL classes during the exchange program. Students who do not meet the concurrent status requirements are only able to take ESL classes during the exchange program.

***Costs are estimates only. Room and meal plan rates vary based on type. The cost of medical insurance, books, and supplies is not included. **Classes in Engineering, Business, Computer Science and Nursing have an additional surcharge of \$90 per credit;** and certain courses have an additional laboratory fee which varies by course.

1. Double occupancy room (January 8 – May 9, 2025)
2. Bronze meal plan (January 11 – May 9, 2025)
3. Room deposit is refundable at the end of the semester if no damage is done to the Residence Hall property.
4. Medical insurance is mandatory. We will purchase the PSI health insurance for all the international students. The cost will automatically be applied to your SMU student account. <https://psiservice.com/stmartin>
