

Campus Life at UCSB

Academic Year Structure

The UCSB academic year is divided into three quarters, each approximately 12 weeks long. To maintain full-time status for F1 visa purposes, students must enroll in 12 U.S. credits per quarter (typically equivalent to 20 ECTS, based on 30 hours per ECTS credit).

Programs & Fees

University Immersion Program (UIP) - \$6,970/Quarter

The UIP offers flexibility for students to select <u>three</u> academic or professional coursework courses. Students can enroll in UCSB PaCE professional classes and/or UCSB undergraduate and graduate classes (subject to prerequisites).

At the end of the program, they can receive a Certificate of Completion and request a transcript. Transcript records for Open University coursework are not automatically sent to UCSB's Registrar and/or Office of Admissions. To request a PaCE Official transcript, students will need to follow the instructions in <u>How to order a Transcript</u>.

UCSB Pace will not issue a transcript on the student's behalf.

International Diploma Program (IDP) - \$5,950/Quarter

In the IDP, students complete three courses from UCSB PaCE professional courses, receiving a diploma upon completion. The professional courses are equal to 36 hours per course.

Choose from specialized diplomas:

- Global Business Leadership (12 units)
- Advanced Digital Marketing (12 units)
- Strategic Influence & Project Management (12 units)
- Business Economics and Management Essentials (12 units)
- Professional Certificate in Management, Business, and Economic Principles (36 units)

Tuition Fees Include

- 3 academic/ professional courses
- Student Services & Immigration Advising
- Student Health Insurance (excluding Dental & Vision)
- Access to UCSB Facilities (Library, Recreation Center, etc.)
- UCSB Student ID & Email
- Free public transportation
- Campus Wi-Fi
- Handshake for academic year students

Additional Fees:

If students decide to enroll in a 4th course, additional fees will apply:

• Undergraduate Units: \$281/unit

• **Graduate Units:** \$325/unit

• Professional Courses: \$685 per additional course

• Technology fees: 2.96/ unit

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Completing a full academic year (9 months) allows F1 visa students to apply for Optional Practical Training (OPT). OPT permits students to work in the U.S. for up to one year in paid employment related to their field of study while maintaining their F1 visa.

To apply, submit the following:

- Copy of your passport
- Proof of English proficiency
- Official academic transcripts (GPA 2.8 or higher)
- Financial statement (covering tuition and estimated living expenses)
- Non-refundable application fee of \$210


